Professional Family Teachers

Our Professional Family Teachers (also known as PFTs) are the program's most valuable resource. They are GoodLife contractors who are pre-screened, professionally trained, and very carefully matched with an individual. Our specialized matching process ensures that parents, guardians, PFTs, and the person served all benefit from becoming an extended family.

SHARED LIVING HOMES

Shared Living homes are located throughout the counties served by GoodLife. Homes are private family homes that Professional Family Teachers own or rent.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Shared Living Homes support and encourage community involvement that is individualized and provides opportunities for residents to participate in events and activities outside their home or day service program.
